

#### **Background**

This permit was issued upon discovery of an easement encroachment from a newly constructed Accessory Dwelling Unit (ADU) at 358 Walsh Road in Town of Atherton (Town.) The ADU's foundation and construction methods damaged the public sewer pipeline. A segment of the existing 6" public sewer main along the southerly side of the property was in conflict with the ADU's foundation and was relocated and replaced with a new 8" sewer main. The new sewer main installed and construction work consisted of approximately 260 feet of 8" sewer main, removing one manhole, and adding a new manhole.

#### **Analysis**

The Board issued this Class 3 Permit No. 1624 at the Regular Meeting of June 22, 2022.

The work has been completed, inspected, tested, and approved by staff as being in conformance with District standards. The property owner has submitted a one-year guarantee for the work in the form of a maintenance bond.

#### Recommendation

The Project Manager recommends that the Board accepts these facilities and directs the General Manager to approve Class 3 Permit No. 1624.



Subject: General Manager's Report

#### 1) Administrative:

- a. The San Mateo County LAFCo Public Hearing was held on Wednesday, February 7, 2024, at 2:30 pm. LAFCo upheld their decision to make EPASD a subsidiary district of the City of East Palo Alto.
- b. Bidnet Direct has been implemented and is now live. The first bids to be advertised on the new platform will be the Willow Pump Station Project and the Point Repair Project Phase II. The new bidding platform is linked to the new and old website.
- c. The District has three Board of Directors positions up for election in 2024. The three incumbents must submit paperwork to the county by August of this year.
- d. The District flows at the Menlo Park Pump Station are back to pre-pandemic levels. The flows for 2023 were 3.45 million gallons per daily (MGD) average compared to 3.46 MGD in 2019. This could represent an increase in Silicon Valley Clean Water O&M monthly charges.

#### 2) Finance:

- a. The District received a Solid Waste Surplus Distribution in the amount of \$317,824.00 from Recology for year 2022. Reconciliation of such accounts occur one to two years in the arrears. The 2023 surplus or shortfall should be distributed in 2025.
- b. Staff along with HF&H will bring the 2024 Sewer Service Charge rate study to the Board during the February 14, 2024, Regular Board Meeting.

#### 3) CIP Projects:

#### a. Construction Capital Improvement Program (CIP):

 Ranger Pipelines submitted a revised construction schedule for the Bayfront Improvements Project. The underground pipeline work is scheduled to begin in March.

#### b. Levee Improvement Project:

- i. Anderson Pacific has completed the first phase of the levee project and should begin phase II during the next construction season.
- ii. With phase I of the levee project being complete, staff will begin to ask for reimbursement from the Nation Fish and Wildlife Foundation grant.

#### 4) Information Technology (IT):

 Staff provided the Board with an update on migrating to the Cloud during the January 24, 2024, Regular Board Meeting.

#### 5) Operations and Maintenance:

#### a. Collection System:

i. Designated staff members were out in the field during the recent severe storms. We are happy to report that we did not experience any issues at our creek crossings and other related areas in the system.

#### b. Pump Facilities:

i. The Pump Facility Supervisor will give an update on the Private STEP/Grider Systems to the Board during the February 28, 2024 Regular Board Meeting.

#### c. Training:

i. Maintenance staff received Hazardous Waste training on February 5, 2024.

#### 6) Water Quality:

#### a. Sharon Heights Golf and Country Club (SHGCC):

 The 2024 Operation & Maintenance budget for the recycled water facility was submitted and approved. The new annual budget is \$671,950 per year or \$55,996 per month.

#### b. Bayfront Recycled Water Facility (BRWF):

i. The Recycled Water Committee met with the Project Management team on January 23, 2024, to review the Request for Proposal documents before they are sent to the qualified contractor. The RFP will be out in March of 2024.

#### c. Woodside Recycled Water Facility (WRWF):

 The Woodside Recycled Water Facility feasibility study is complete and will be brought to the Board on March 12, 2024. Staff will seek reimbursement from the State Water Board grant that was awarded for the study.

#### 7) Fleet and Facilities:

#### a. Vehicle Maintenance:

i. The new Dump Truck is expected to arrive by late June 2024.

#### 8) Personnel:

i. General Manager will be on vacation from March 28 till April 6, 2024. The Water Quality Manager and Operations Superintendent will be in charge in his absence.

#### 9) Upcoming Events:

a. Next Regular Board Meetings: Wednesdays, February 14 & 28, 2024.

#### 10) Misc. Items

- a. **West Bay:** The General Manager will update the Board on miscellaneous items related to District operations.
- b. **Town of Los Altos Hills:** The Town continues to replace the oversize manhole lids with standard lids that are more manageable to lift and maintain.
- c. **Town of Woodside:** The Pump Crew responded to a power outage at the Town Center Pump Station during recent storm events.

Rate Study for Fiscal Year 2024/25

#### **Background**

West Bay Sanitary District procured the services of HF&H LLC, who has agreed to perform a Sewer Service Charge Rate Study for FY 2024/25. HF&H LLC is in the process of analyzing the proper rate structure to support the District's Operation & Maintenance (O&M) and Capital Replacement needs and to meet O&M and Debt Service obligations for the Silicon Valley Clean Water regional treatment plant.

#### <u>Analysis</u>

From discussion on the HF&H analysis to date, the Board will be requested to provide policy direction on the potential sewer service charges for FY 2024/25. Using a rate model, HF&H will demonstrate the effects on revenue of projected rate levels in order to maintain operating and non-operating expenses, CIP projects, and reserve levels overall.

#### Fiscal Impact

There is no fiscal impact at this time, however implementation of new sewer service charges and/or connection fees would impact District revenues. A Proposition 218 Notice would follow at a later date.

#### Recommendation

The General Manager recommends the Board engage in discussion and provide staff with policy direction regarding the sewer service charges for FY2024-25.

Subject: Authorize the General Manager to Purchase a Mini Excavator

#### **Background**

The District has approximately 1422 mainline segments in easements out of approximately 5,300 line segments. When these segments need repairs from defects such as roots, breaks, collapsed pipe, or sags the inhouse Rehab Crew must hand dig these repairs. The work requires two to three crew members to hand dig and perform the repair over a two-day period. Sometimes the repairs take longer than two days depending on the length and severity.

Over the past several years the crew has rented a mini excavator to make repairs more efficient. When a mini excavator is used most repairs can be completed within the same day.

Staff has rented a mini excavator 12 to 14 times from 2021-2023 for an approximate cost of \$25,822. This includes the equipment cost and does not include the time to pick up and return the rental unit.

#### **Analysis**

The Board approved \$60,000 to purchase a new 2024 Mini Excavator in the FY 2023/24 Budget.

Staff researched an Electric Mini Excavator, however, the \$82,423 price for the unit was not justifiable particularly because it did not include the needed accessories and was not cost effective. The retail price for the basic diesel 2024 Mini Excavator is \$39,643.00 without options or extra attachments (see Bobcat quote.)

The District has used Sourcewell to take advantage of a cooperative bid process and lower pricing on numerous occasions. The District received a quote through Sourcewell for a basic diesel unit in the amount of \$30,949.60 (\$33,783.28 including two trenching buckets) a savings of \$8,693.40 from the retail price for the same unit (see Sourcewell quote.)

Staff solicited two additional bids for similar equipment from Tri-West Tractor, Inc. and Peterson CAT. The Tri-West Tractor quote was \$45,190.00 while the Peterson quote was \$76,316.36.

#### Fiscal Impact

Fiscal impact is \$30,949.60 plus \$25,699.77 for accessories such as Buckets, a Hydraulic Compactor, a Hydraulic Breaker Bar and a Trailer for a total of \$56,649.37, The funds will be used from the Equipment Replacement Fund.

#### Recommendation

The Assistant Operations Superintendent recommends the Board Authorize the General Manager to Purchase a Mini Excavator and accessories.
