## Tanker Truck, Water

- Pre-inspect equipment including rental equipment.
- Pre-operate equipment including rental equipment.
- Review and understand the manufacturer's operator's manual for this equipment.
- Never leave the machine unattended with the engine running.
- Check air brakes for proper connections.
- Be aware of possible load surge when turning/braking.
- Allow for additional stopping distance required when loaded.
- Check dispensing nozzles, valves, and hoses prior to leaving the yard.
- Do not enter tanker unless following confined spaces, rules and procedures.
