West Bay Sanitary District Passes Resolution for No Rate Increase for Solid Waste (Garbage/Recycling) Collection in 2014

Menlo Park, CA – On October 9, 2013 the West Bay Sanitary District Board of Directors made it official that the District's 2,200 solid waste customers in unincorporated San Mateo County will not see an increase in rates in 2014. Passed, four to zero, Resolution 1851, ensures customers will keep the same monthly rates which were originally passed by the Board in December 2012.

"We are pleased that there will be no rate increase for our solid waste customers in 2014," said WBSD Director Fran Dehn. "It's very important for our customers to have the services from Recology that provide them with recycling, organic materials and solid waste collection and not have an increase in rates for the upcoming year."

West Bay Sanitary District is one of twelve Member Agencies of the South Bayside Waste Management Authority (SBWMA or RethinkWaste). RethinkWaste owns the Shoreway Environmental Center in San Carlos where all the recyclables, compost and solid waste are delivered by Recology. RethinkWaste also assists the Member Agencies with administering their collection services contract with Recology.

Recology San Mateo County provides collection services for refuse, recyclable materials, and compostable materials under a ten-year franchise agreement with the City which began January 2011.
